Successful application for the 2018 – 2020 Strategic Partnership Program (SPP)

The Victorian Association for Philosophy in Schools (VAPS) is excited to announce that the Association was one of the successful applicants for Victorian Government's SPP grants for 2018-2020.

The grant will build on VAPS' notable work supporting rural and regional Victorian students and teachers to access events run by VAPS. This will include the ever popular Unit 3 and 4 VCE Philosophy Forums, the academically rigorous Primary, Middle and Secondary Philosophons, the Ethical Capability workshops as well as the planned VCE Network meetings. The grant also provides funding for rural and regional Victorian teachers to attend the VAPS Conference in September, 2018. The grant will be used to sponsor or subsidise the cost of events, travel expenses and accommodation and other operations depending on need and demand.
